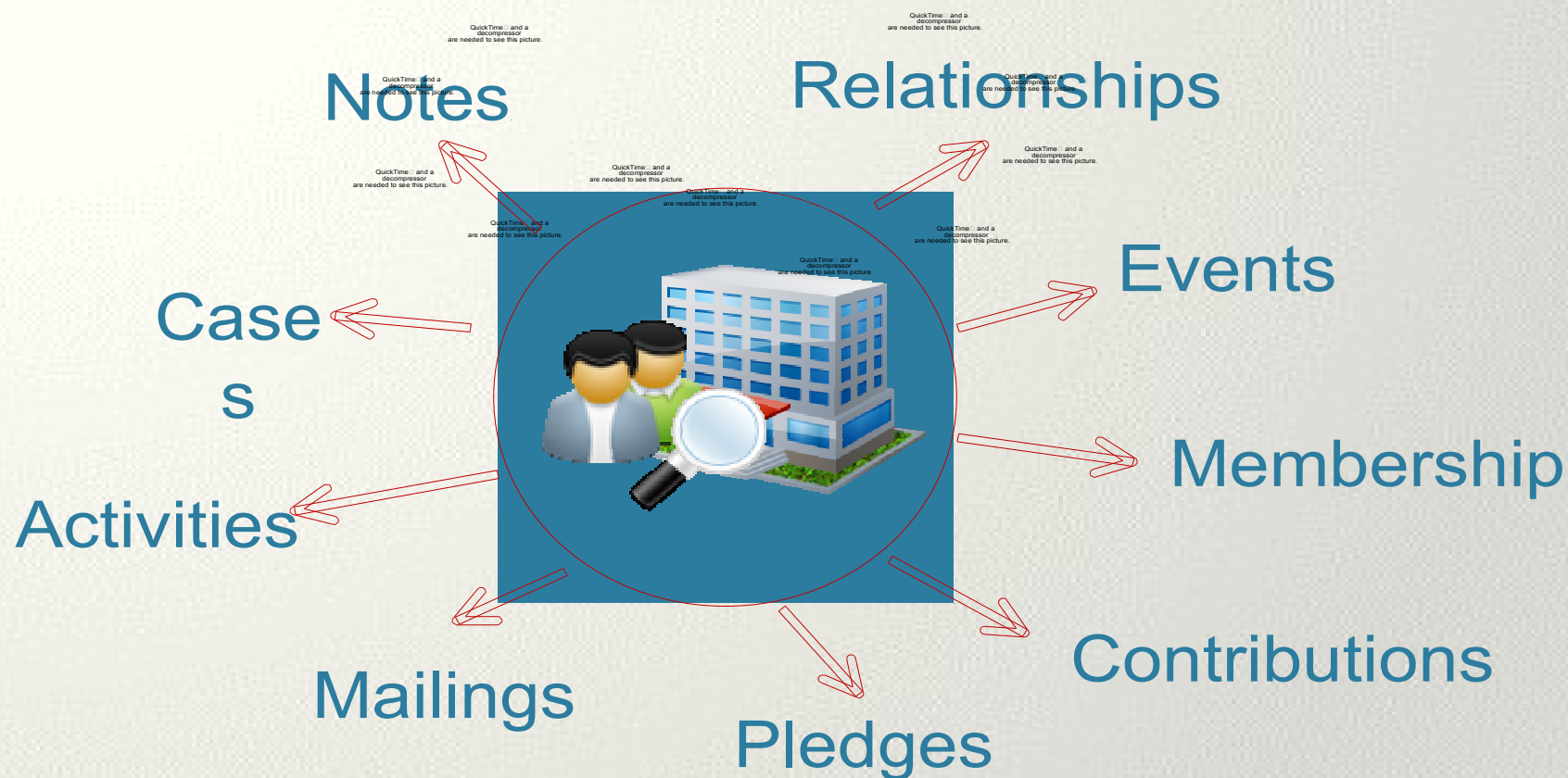

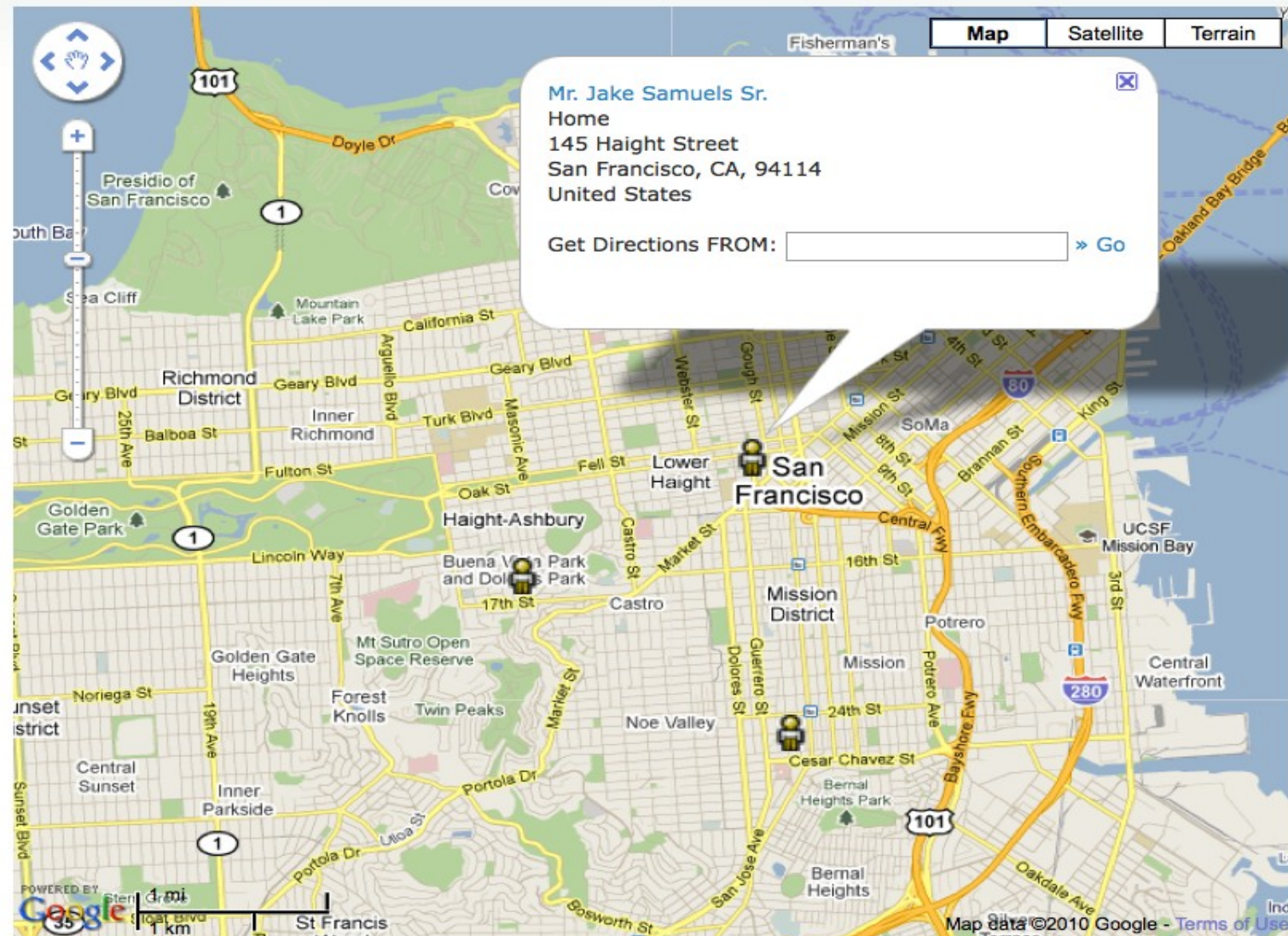

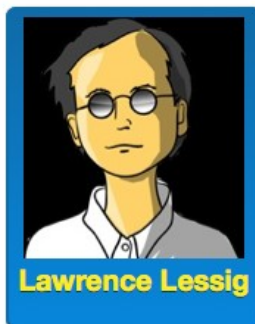

About 8 years ago, a bunch of us started thinking about how we might make the current system of copyright work better. We wanted a voluntary system that would give people a simple way to signal the freedom they wanted their creative work to carry, so their work would say legally what most took the Net to say implicitly — share this. The result was Creative Commons, born December 16, 2002.

None of us imagined then just how quickly the idea would spread. Parallel projects have been launched in over 50 countries around the world, and hundreds of millions of digital objects now live on the Net free to be (legally) shared. CC has become essential infrastructure for the sharing economy of the web — used by an incredible range of creators and entities, from the White House to Wikipedia, from Nine Inch Nails to David Byrne.

We need to support this infrastructure. I in particular — feeling the guilt of an absent father, having been called to another, more [fundamental battle](#) — need my friends to help support this infrastructure. The staff at Creative Commons (and Science Commons and ccLearn and CC International) are wildly underpaid. Yet they have done an enormous amount to make this

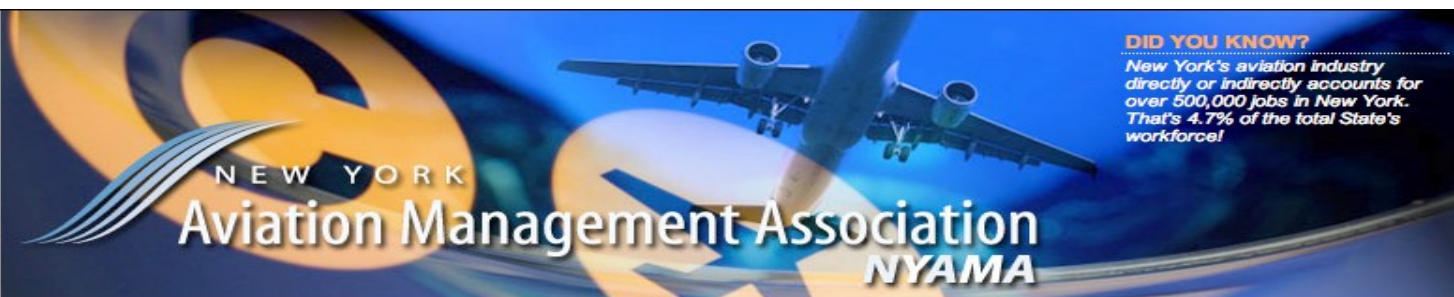

What do you need to use CiviCRM?



- Prepare your Server
 - Web-site running Drupal or Joomla CMS
- Prepare your data
 - Export your data and clean it up prior to importing it
 - Prepare your data import file
- Technical resource to do the installation
 - Install the software and integrate/configure it in the server
 - Install and configure the database
- Train your folks
 - Train your team on CiviCRM (managing data and donors)
 - Train your administrators on how to manage CiviCRM



What does CiviCRM cost?

- It depends....
 - Size of your data
 - Complexity of your organization
 - Your specific needs (e.g. how much needs to be customized?)
- At a minimum, you will need
 - Administrative resources to maintain your data (if you already have a system, these people can likely learn CiviCRM)
 - Technical admin resources to manage CiviCRM
 - Deduplication
 - Data import/exports
 - Event, profiles, custom data configuration
 - Other configuration
- You may need development resources to
 - Customize CiviCRM
 - Develop custom reports



Choosing partner(s)

- Where do you need help?
 - Design, Configure and Customize
 - Data Migration
 - Hosting
 - Ongoing support and maintenance (upgrades!)
- Partner selection is critical
 - Experience w/ open source + specific platform(s)
 - Experience w/ organizations and implementations like yours (features, scale, user profile ...)
 - Best practices approach to customization

- The Profile is responsible for creating a Drupal user account as well as collecting contact information.
- Two payment gateways (PayJunction and PayPal) times Membership Duration possibilities (Yearly / Monthly) = Four Contribution Pages

- Since CiviCRM is “running the show” and causing a Drupal user account to be created, then it is up to CiviCRM to place the new user account into the correct Drupal group(s) to establish site permissions.
- CiviCRM includes a Drupal module to do just that: CiviMember Roles Sync
- Depending on which CiviCRM group memberships are granted to a CiviCRM account, corresponding Drupal group permissions are assigned.

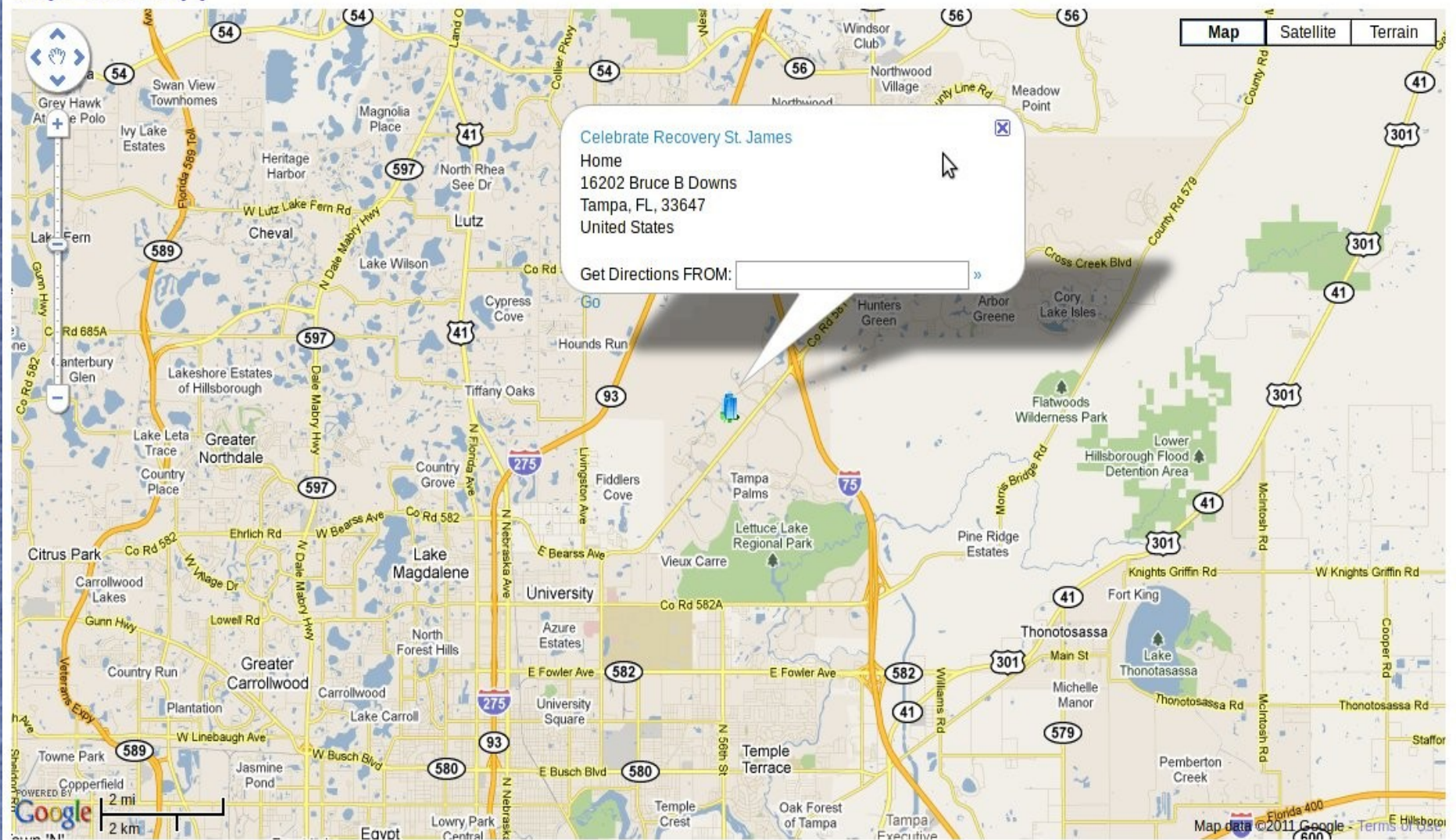
